In offering this vital visiting hospice service at no cost to clients or their families, CCN depends on well-trained hospice volunteers. The organization is offering a 30-hour hospice core training program that is mandatory for new volunteers who will be preparing themselves for being involved with helping to ease the journey of local residents and their families facing serious life-threatening illness, palliative diagnosed, needing end of life support, and grief and bereavement care.

This next core training session begins on Friday March 29th, 2019 from 9:00am-12:00pm and runs for 10 consecutive weeks at its Cobourg Office. The training includes classes, readings, specialized guest speakers, visuals, discussions and hands-on experiences in readying volunteers for the joys and challenges of this work.

Upon completion of this core training, participants will have gained a better understanding into the philosophy of hospice care, comfort measures for end-of-life clients, attitudes toward death and dying, communication, family dynamics, grief and loss, and more.
