

Hiring Begins for Ed's House Northumberland Hospice Care Centre

Community Care Northumberland (CCN) has begun the recruitment process for clinical and support staff at Ed's House Northumberland Hospice Care Centre. Led by CCN, the new facility located in Hamilton township will provide residential care, along with a new home for our current community hospice staff providing services such as; grief and bereavement support, education, caregiver support and health system navigation to hospice clients, their families and their caregivers. Ed's House is expected to welcome its first residents this fall.

The deadline to apply for the Building Maintenance Custodian is June 12th, 2020 and the deadline for applications for Registered Nurses, Registered Practical Nurses, Personal Support Workers and Food Service Coordinator is June 30th, 2020.
