Community Care Northumberland (CCN) tries to make life better for the residents of Trent Hills; helping people remain independent in their own homes and programs that support their families and caregivers. Currently, the Municipality of Trent Hills annually donates \$45,500 to CCN which allows us to leverage additional gas tax support for our specialized transportation program.
