Zone (per PH)	Operation	Restrictions
ORANGE	Visiting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- three visitors at any given time, with up to five total visitors for compassionate reasons with the approval of the Medical Director- common areas off-limits, except spiritual and quiet rooms available with pre-arrangement, social distancing and masks required- alternative visit types (video-call, window) encouraged- outdoor visits can be pre-arranged with clinical staff, maximum group of 6 (including resident) for outdoor visits- visitors shall wear surgical mask at all times in isolation rooms- in non-isolation rooms, mask optional unless staff are in the room, when it must be worn
	Admissions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- COVID-19 swab with negative result prior to admission- 14-day isolation on admission
	Community Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- virtual only
	Volunteers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- no in-person visits- virtual only, no volunteer support to residence
	Meetings/Events/Rounds	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- all virtual
	Human Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- no access to residence unless required- self-screening at home prior to arrival at work, and work from home if any symptoms of COVID-19, following Public Health guidelines- only essential contract work/maintenance in residence- physical distancing at all times, with all staff encouraged to work remotely where feasible
	Screening/PPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- screening questionnaire + temperature for all staff and visitors upon entering- surgical mask worn by all staff and visitors in the building at any time when in a space with other people- eye protection worn by clinical staff for duration of shift, and by non-clinical staff when outside personal office- physical distancing and routine hand hygiene, including at entry
